

Ballet Attire

- Hair** In keeping with the traditions of classical ballet, girls must wear hair fastened securely in a bun on the back of the head for all classes. With the exception of the 3 and 4 year olds this applies to all levels, all the time.
- Shoes** Full-soled leather pink ballet slippers, purchased from a dance specialty store. The shoes sold in discount stores or shoe stores often use inferior materials and are not suitable for ballet. Two manufacturers that we recommend are Capezio and Bloch. You must take your child to the store to be fitted. Sizing is different from street shoes. Shoes should not be bought with room to grow. Otherwise, proper use of the foot is not possible.
- Tights** Please check throughout the year for the need to purchase larger sizes as your child grows. Tights that are too small are very uncomfortable.
- Sweaters** For the younger students if they would like to wear a sweater in colder weather please use Eurotard 72523C or Body Wrappers Style #105 in Light Pink (through Ballet I) or Black for Ballet II and up.
- Jewelry** Small earrings may be worn but no other jewelry is allowed.

Boys Boys wear a white t-shirt or white short sleeve leotard, black tights or black gym shorts, short white ankle socks, and white or black ballet shoes. For Contemporary, you may wear footless tights, and for footwear: Dance Paws or Capezio Footundeez.

Contemporary

Girls/Women: Black leotard (any style), pink or black convertible tights (Prima Soft 101), soffe-type shorts (optional), Dance Paws or Capezio FootUndeez for feet. Hair may be in a ponytail.

Extras

Ballet IV and V students are strongly encouraged to have a nude camisole leotard to wear under leotards and costumes when necessary for modesty. There are many manufacturers of this item. Plastic straps that have several options for the way they are attached are very useful.

Costumes
